Common Milkweed is a native plant found in roadsides, meadows, and pastures throughout Virginia.

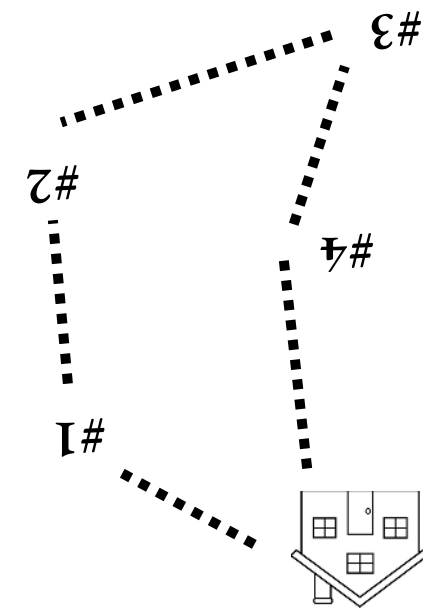
